Saint Louis School Junior Prom Contract and Permission Form *“To Infinity and Beyond”*

1. Info: **March 23, 2012 Friday** **Hale Koa Hotel 6:00–10:00 pm** **Attire: Formal**

2. This is a formal affair and formal attire is expected. Students and their guests must follow the appropriate dress code, or they may be sent home to change and your parents will be called. Formal dress code for **males** is: collared shirt, dress slacks/pants/coat, dress shoes. The dress code does not allow t-shirts, jeans, shorts, rubber slippers, athletic or casual shoes, sunglasses, hats. The dress code for **females** is: **NO** dresses with exposed midriffs, see-through materials, extreme low cut neck-line, slits higher than the fingertips when the arms are rested to the side, dress backs that are lower than bra strap level. Additional male school rules apply, i.e.) hair, facial hair, and earrings.

3. Both this **completed permission form and \$100 payment must be presented upon purchase of a bid.** The cost is subsidized by Student council dues and Division dues. Make checks payable to **Saint Louis School**. Bids will be sold beginning **Wednesday, February 22, 2012 to Wednesday, March 7th in Ms. Paiaina’s room (B22) in the morning before homeroom, at recess and after school.** Re-selling of bids is not permitted. No refunds will be given. Required paperwork must be submitted when purchasing a bid. **Table assignments will be on a first come first serve bases on Monday March 19th and Tuesday March 20th.** No table switching. (1) Etiquette class is MANDATORY for each SLS student

4. You and your guest must have a picture ID available upon request on the night of the event. All participants must be of at least high school age, and no older than 20 years.

5. Students and their guests are to behave in an orderly fashion and abide by school and site rules, as well as state and federal laws. Cigarettes, alcoholic beverages, and other forms of drugs are not allowed.

6. The dance policy must be followed: No freaking, No making out or touching/rubbing of private areas: No putting face near partner’s private areas; No lifting of clothing; No lap dancing, moshing, crowd-surfing, and break-dancing. You are responsible for your guest. Consequences will include: First offense—Verbal warning and a 15 minute time out in a designated area. Second offense—Administrative action.

7. All students and their guest are expected to stay throughout the entire event from 6-10pm. You and your date will not be allowed to leave early. Please make arrangements appropriately. If you and/or your date must leave early, please turn in a **written statement** from you and your date’s parent/guardian with this form, which must also include their signatures. This is due to Ms. Paiaina/Ms Tuyay by **March 19th**. There will be **NO EXCEPTIONS** to this rule.

8. Students and their guests who leave the event before its termination will not be the responsibility of Saint Louis School. Re-entry will not be allowed to those who leave the premises without permission.
