

## Saint Louis School, Honolulu Hawaii

Representatives from Saint Louis School's Japanese language classes and club joined students from Uwajima Fisheries High School in Ehime Prefecture at a memorial service February 16 to mark the 11th anniversary of a collision between its training boat and a U.S. nuclear submarine that killed nine people off O'ahu.

A brief social followed the prayer at the Ehime Maru Memorial in Kaka'ako Waterfront Park, including faculty and staff from both schools. The activity is one of several between Saint Louis School and Ehime Prefecture during February. Saint Louis Japanese Club student volunteers have cleaned the memorial monthly since 2002.

The Ehime Maru sank on Feb. 9, 2001, in an accident involving the 6,080-ton USS Greeneville performing a rapid-surfacing drill.
