Interested in being a **Teacher’s Aide** this summer? See Miss Carrasquillo. Earn ½ elective credit.

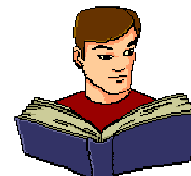

**Integrated Mathematics & Science Class** Calculate the average distance a water-filled balloon can travel without breaking.

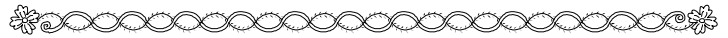
